

Whatever you're building, if it costs more than \$40,000 you must pay the **Portable Long Service Leave Levy.**



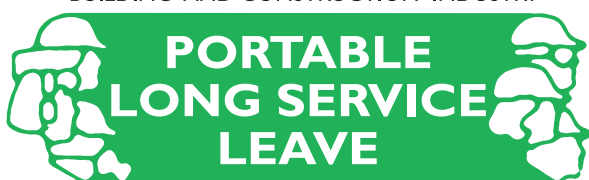
Whether it's pyramids or pools, shearing sheds or shops, mansions or maisonettes, if the contract price is \$40,000 or more, then a portable Long Service Levy of 0.5 per cent of the contract price is payable before work begins. Extensions and alterations are included as well as new projects.

The Levy must be paid at the same time as notifying The Division of Workplace Health and Safety of a notifiable project, using the same form. Levies not paid at this time may incur an interest charge of 2% per month.

The Levy must be paid by:

- the principal contractor responsible for carrying out the work
- if there is no such principal contractor - the person or body responsible for carrying out the work, or
- if there is not a person or body responsible for carrying out the work- the person or body for which the building or construction work is being carried out (ie. The owner).
